CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: Call for proposals for Set-up, integration and process development

This call aims at establishing a dedicated pilot line for Photonic Integrated Circuits within Europe. As part of the Chips Joint Undertaking (JU), it focuses on advancing PIC technologies beyond the current state-of-the-art and fostering collaboration among research institutions, SMEs, and large corporations across Europe to accelerate their commercialisation. Total call budget: 100.000.000 €.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe Programme – Chips Joint Undertaking (JU)

Call & Topic ID: HORIZON-Chips-2024-RIA-CPL-5

Deadline: September 17th 2024

Applicants: legal entities established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sector: Photonic Integrated Circuits

Partnership: required

European Partnership on Innovative SMEs / Innowide CALL 3

The Innowide programme helps innovative SMEs willing to compete in new international markets by supporting market feasibility projects. A market feasibility project includes preliminary technical, market, legal, and/or socioeconomic assessments intended to validate the feasibility of international and innovative business solutions within new and emerging global value chains. Each successful project will receive a fixed grant of 60.000 €.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - European Partnership on the Innovative SMEs

Call & Topic ID: HORIZON-EIE-2021-INNOVSMES-01-01

Deadline: October 15th 2024

Applicants: Innovative SMEs, including young companies and start-ups from any sector

Activity sector: internationalisation

Partnership: required (each market feasibility project must include at least an applicant SME and an independent subcontractor - local counterpart - in the target country)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

aerOS: Open call #2

aerOS aims at establishing a common meta Operating System that follows a collaborative IoT-Edge–Cloud architecture supporting flexible deployments (e.g., federated or hierarchical). The second open call funds small projects that validate aerOS architecture and focus on one of the following [use cases](#) to extend its functionalities and applications. A maximum of 8 proposals will be funded with up to 60.000€

Deadline: September 30th 2024

Applicants: European SMEs, Universities, Research centres (RTOs) and individuals

Activity sectors: innovation, twin transition and internationalisation

Partnership: not required

SEE BRIDGE: Open call

This open call launched within the SEE BRIDGE project aims to support the Social Economy SMEs from the energy-intensive sectors in their Twin Transition (Green & Digital) and to enable them to easily adapt to the new CBAM regulation requirements. It will grant 60 applicants up to 8.000 €/each to fund a combination of business support services, consulting, in-company training, and attendance of relevant events.

Deadline: October 1st 2024

Applicants: Social Economy SME (including start-ups), established in EU Member States or associated countries, operating in the energy intensive industries or in sectors that are part of upstream or downstream value chains in the energy-intensive industry ecosystem

Activity sectors: twin transition

Partnership: not required

FORTHCOMING

Horizon Europe: Resource Efficiency of PV in Production, Use and Disposal

This call aims at reducing the environmental footprint associated with Photovoltaic technology deployment across all the phases of the system lifetime (production, transport, installation, and end of

life) and at defining guidelines to optimally address the circularity of PV systems for one or several PV technologies (silicon, thin film, organic PV, perovskite PV, etc.). Total call budget: 3.000.000 €.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 5 – Climate, Energy and Mobility

Call & Topic ID: Sustainable, secure and competitive energy supply (HORIZON-CL5-2024-D3-02)

Planned opening date: September 17th 2024

Deadline: February 4th 2024

Applicants: legal entities established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sector: internationalisation

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)
