CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: The European Social Innovation Competition 2024

The European Social Innovation Competition (EUSIC) aims at stimulating the potential of social innovation to provide solutions to societal challenges and to foster sustainable and inclusive growth in Europe. In 2024, the competition is focused on digital social innovation to strengthen the EU's democratic space through new, scalable digital technologies or innovative use and commercialization of existing ones. The 3 best-ranked solutions will respectively receive 75.000 €, 50.000 € and 25.000 €.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe

Call & Topic ID: The European Social Innovation Competition 2024 (HORIZON-EIC-2024-EUSIC-PRIZE-04)

Deadline: 11th June 2024

Applicants: a natural person or a legal entity established EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries

Activity sectors: social innovation

Partnership: not required

Social Prerogative and Specific Competencies Lines: Support for Social Dialogue 2024

This call aims at contributing to the promotion of social dialogue at cross-industry and sectoral levels, developing European social dialogue, and building and strengthening the capacity of national social partners. European social dialogue refers to discussions, consultations, negotiations, and joint actions involving organisations representing either side of the industry (employers or workers).

Total call budget: 13.250.000 €.

Funding programme: Social Prerogative and Specific Competencies Lines Programme

Call & Topic ID: Support for social dialogue (SOCPL-2024-SOC-DIALOG)

Deadline: July 10th 2024

Applicants: social partners organisations established in eligible countries (EU Member States or candidate countries)

Activity sector: social dialogue

Partnership: not required

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

Up2Circ First Open Call

In its first open call, Up2Circ Accelerator will support up to 47 projects to validate the adoption of circular business models and implement concrete actions toward circular products, processes, and services. The total call budget is 1.230.000 € and the following funding schemes are foreseen:

- Small-scale projects: Feasibility studies – up to 15.000 €;
- Large-scale projects: Piloting and demonstration – up to 50.000 €.

Deadline: May 31st 2024

Applicants: SMEs from EU Member States already involved in the activities of the Up2Circ Academy

Activity sectors: circular economy

Partnership: not required

In Transit 2nd call Innovate

The current Open Call aims at supporting and guiding 50 SMEs in the self-exploration of the current business model towards a new circular business model, improving processes or developing new products, by providing them with individual and group-level services.

Deadline: June 4th 2024

Applicants: innovative SMEs from EU Member States, active in Aerospace, Construction, Textile, Advanced manufacturing sectors

Activity sectors: circular economy

Partnership: not required
