# **CALLS FOR PROPOSALS**

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli <u>obiettivi politici</u> della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

### European Defence Fund (EDF): Work programme 2025

The European Commission launched the 2025 Work Programme for the European Defence Fund (EDF), which supports collaborative research and development in defence. With a total budget of €1.065 billion, this programme aims to enhance the development of critical defence technologies across all military domains, including ground, air, naval, space, and cyber. It focuses on strengthening industrial

competitiveness, promoting interoperability, and supporting SMEs and mid-caps under the EU Defence Innovation Scheme (EUDIS).

Deadline: October 16<sup>th</sup> 2025
Applicants: Legal entities from EU Member States, Norway, and associated countries
Activity sector: defence/dual-use technologies
Partnership: required (at least three independent legal entities, each established in different Member States or EDF associated countries)

# EUIPO: SME Fund 2025

The Ideas Powered for Business SME Fund is a grant scheme designed to help EU SMEs protect their intellectual property (IP) rights. The SME Fund is a reimbursement programme that issues vouchers that can be used to partially cover the fees for selected activities. There are different types of voucher available depending on the activity concerned: a)  $700 \in$  for trade mark and design fees; b)  $1000 \in$  for national patents fees and prior art search services; c)  $2500 \in$  for European patents fees and legal costs; d)  $1500 \in$  for community plant variety online application fees. Funds are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

### **CASCADE FUNDING**

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

#### EIT RawMaterials - ERMA Booster Call

The ERMA Booster Call aims to support innovative start-ups, scale-ups, and mining projects in the raw materials sector by providing financial assistance (up to  $\leq 2.5$  million per selected project) and access to expert guidance and Europe's largest network of industry leaders. Eligible start-ups can receive funding up to  $\leq 0.5$ m, eligible scale-ups, and SMEs can receive up to  $\leq 1.5$ m, eligible mining projects, and recycling projects with advanced extraction, processing, or recycling capabilities can receive up to  $\leq 2.5$ m.

Deadlines: Cut-off 1 (March 24<sup>th</sup>), Cut-off 2 (March 26<sup>th</sup>), Cut-off 3 (September 8<sup>th</sup>) 2025

Applicants: Start-ups, scale-ups, SMEs, and mining/recycling projects active in the raw materials value chain

Activity sectors: raw materials, mining, recycling, advanced materials innovation

Partnership: optional (proposals can be submitted by either single applicant or consortia)

#### Up2Circ - Second Open Call

The Up2Circ program aims to support small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in adopting circular business models and implementing innovations in circular products, processes, and services. The initiative offers fixed funding for 28 small-scale projects (€15.000, duration 6 months) and 12 large-scale projects (€50.000, duration 12 months).

Planned opening date: March 1st 2025

### Deadline: April 30th 2025

*Applicants*: SMEs based in EU member states. SMEs from Horizon Europe Associated Countries are not eligible for this particular call

Activity sectors: Circular economy/sustainability

Partnership: not required (proposals must be submitted by a single entity)

### FORTHCOMING

#### Horizon Europe: Clean Aviation JU 2025 - Call 3

Clean Aviation has announced its Call 3 for Proposals, scheduled for launch on 20 February 2025. This call will allocate up to €350 million in EU funding to support research and innovation projects aimed at advancing sustainable and environmentally friendly aviation technologies. The call is also introducing a new initiative to play a crucial role in advancing disruptive technologies: the Fast Track Areas (FTAs) for a total funding volume of €15 million. Priority will be given to projects that can rapidly advance impactful technologies to the development phase, encouraging the participation of universities, research centres, and SMEs.

Planned opening date: 20 February 2025

Applicants: Legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sector: sustainable aviation technologies

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)
